1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the rules of the Pelican Sailing Association (Inc.).
- 1.2 The regatta will also abide by the rules of the Pelican Sailing Association (Inc.)
- 1.3 The regatta will also be governed by the Pelican Sailing Association code of conduct.

2 Advertising

2.1 Competitor advertising will be restricted as follows. Boats shall not display advertising unless authorised by the Organising Authority.

3 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 Entry is open to all skippers and crew who are financial members of both a club affiliated with Yachting Australia (YA) and the Pelican Sailing Association (Inc.), and possess a current YA youth membership card.
- 3.2 The regatta is open to boats currently registered with the Pelican Sailing Association (Inc.).
- 3.3 Eligible boats may be entered by completing entry and indemnity forms attached to this Notice of Race and lodging them by **20**th **March 2018**
- 3.4 Late registration will not be accepted, unless under exceptional circumstances.
- 3.5 A change of skipper will be approved only in exceptional circumstances.

4 Fees

4.1 The regatta race fee will be \$50 per boat

5 Measurements

5.1 The hull and equipment shall comply with the Rules of Construction and Measurement of the Pelican Sailing Association (Inc.) and hold a valid Measurement Certificate that must be produced at time of registration.
